I have created four different lessons, each covering an important aspect of Clayoquot Sound: an overview, the central region Nuu-chah-nulth Nations, the temperate rainforest, and the coast and the ocean. I have chosen these four sections based on the time I spent in the region. During my time there, I was able to identify what aspects of life in Clayoquot Sound the local community felt were important.
